Offscreen Expeditions is committed to safeguarding your privacy online. We use the information we collect about you to help us understand more about how our site is used and to be able to send you communications about Offscreen Expeditions that may be of interest to you, either electronically or otherwise. 1. What personally identifiable information does Offscreen Expeditions collect from me?

Like many websites, Offscreen Expeditions uses cookies in order to provide you with a more personalised web service. A cookie is a text-only string of information that we pass to your computer's hard disk through your web-browser so that the website can remember who you are. Cookies cannot be used by themselves to identify you.

A cookie will typically contain the name of the domain from which the cookie has come, the "lifetime" of the cookie, and a value, usually a randomly generated unique number.

We use two types of cookies on our website:

- per session cookies, which are temporary cookies that remain in the cookies file of your browser until you leave the site; and
- persistent cookies, which remain in the cookies file of your browser for longer (although how long will depend on the lifetime of the specific cookie). These cookies are used to store state information between visits to a site.

We use persistent cookies to provide certain services, so that you do not have to log-in repeatedly between visits.

If you do not wish to receive cookies you can easily modify your web browser to refuse cookies, or to notify you when you receive a new cookie. However, you may not be able to

use all the interactive features of our site if cookies are disabled, and so in order to enjoy the Offscreen Expedition site to the full, we recommend that you leave them switched on.

2. How does Offscreen Expeditions use my information?

Offscreen Expeditions uses the information we collect about you to help us with understanding more about how our site is used and to be able to send you communications that may be of interest to you, either electronically or otherwise.

Offscreen Expeditions also uses personal information uploaded to specific sites to help in the selection of participants for our expeditions.

3. Who is collecting your information?

When you are on the Offscreen Expedition website and are asked for personal information, you are sharing that information with Offscreen Expeditions alone unless stated otherwise.

4. With whom does Offscreen Expeditions share your information?

Offscreen Expeditions will not disclose any of your personally identifiable information, except when we have your permission or under special circumstances, such as when we believe in good faith that the law requires it.

When you upload personal information as part of an online application to participate in an expedition, we will share this with our expedition partners to assist in the selection process.

5. What are my choices regarding, collection, use and distribution of my information?

If you indicated that you are interested in receiving regular information about Offscreen Expeditions' future projects, we will send you communications regarding Offscreen Expeditions' work and activities, either electronically or otherwise.

Offscreen Expeditions does not sell or rent user information with anyone.

6. What is Offscreen Expeditions' policy on allowing me to update, correct, or delete my personally identifiable information?

The accuracy of your individual identifying information is important to Offscreen Expeditions.
